

Our Lady's RC Primary School

This document explains how places were allocated at the school for admission to reception class in September 2024.

How places were allocated

Our Lady's RC Primary School is a Voluntary Aided School.

All applications were processed using the 'equal preference' system as explained in the 'Admissions to Primary Schools 2024/25 booklet'.

Children with an Education, Health and Care Plan which names the school.
Places offered under this criterion – 0

Criterion 1.

Children who are in public care or have been in public care. Places offered under this criterion - 0

Criterion 2a.

Baptised Roman Catholic Children who will have a brother or sister attending the school at the time of admission, and are resident in the parish of Our Lady's, Haigh.
Places offered under this criterion - 2

Criterion 2b.

Baptised Roman Catholic Children who are resident in the parish of Our Lady's, Haigh. Places offered under this criterion - 7

Criterion 2c.

Baptised Roman Catholic Children who are resident in another parish who will have a brother or sister attending the school at the time of admission. Places offered under this criterion - 0

Criterion 2d.

Baptised Roman Catholic Children who are resident in another parish. Places offered under this criterion - 3

Criterion 3.

Other children who will have a brother or sister attending the school at the time of admission.
Places offered under this criterion - 7

Criterion 4.

Other Children.
Places offered under this criterion - 11

Tie Breaker

Places in criterion 4 were allocated to the 11 pupils living nearest to the school. The last of these places was allocated to a pupil living 0.780 miles from the school.

Applications received after the closing date of 15 January 2024 are deemed to be late and only considered after applications received on time. Changes of preference received after the closing date are also classed as late applications.
