

Hawley Hall High School

This document explains how places were allocated at the school for admission to Year 7 in September 2024.

Admission number (number of places available) - 230

Number of preferences received on time (by the closing date) - 363

How places were allocated

Hawley Hall High School is an Academy School.

All applications were processed using the 'equal preference' system as explained in the 'Admissions to Secondary Schools 2024/25 booklet.

Children with an Education, Health and Care Plan which names the school.

Places offered - 4

Criterion 1. Looked after children, previously looked after children and children who appear to the Local Authority to have been in state care outside of England and ceased to be in state care because they were adopted.

Places offered under this criterion – 2

Criterion 2. Children whose older brother or sister attends the school and will still be there at the time of admission.

Places offered under this criterion - 72

Criterion 3. Other children living in the postcodes WN3-5 and WN3-6.

Places offered under this criterion – 130

Criterion 4. Other children living nearest to the school.

Places offered under this criterion – 22

Tie Breaker

Places in criterion 4 were allocated to the 22 pupils living nearest to the school. The last of these places was allocated to a pupil living 1.668 miles from the school.

Applications received after the closing date of 31 October 2023 are deemed to be late and only considered after applications received on time. Changes of preference received after the closing date are also classed as late applications.
