## 1c) Total - £3,984,627

The names and addresses of the hotels are exempt from disclosure under Section 38 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FoIA). Section 38 (i)(b) states that information is exempt information if its disclosure under this Act would, or would be likely to, endanger the safety of any individual. Disclosure under the FoIA is deemed to be to the world at large. To disclose the full names and addresses of hotels to the world at large would put at risk the safety of vulnerable individuals.

As this a qualified exemption, the Council is required to undertake a public interest test.

The Council acknowledges its obligations of transparency and accountability in all its undertakings. However, in this case, the safeguarding of vulnerable individuals would be put at risk by publishing the names and addresses of hotels and clearly outweighs that. On balance, therefore the Council believes that only the information provided in the attached spreadsheet can be disclosed.
