

We've been visited by a representative of Brsk Network informing us about installations of telegraph poles in the Close with cables going across to properties, we want it to be known that we do object to this and we are also aware that neighbours are of the same mind.

• Could you please communicate any information regarding this matter.

Thank you for your enquiry relating to the installation of telegraph poles in your area. However, the operator does not require permission from the Council to install this type of pole, so we are unable to take any action.

It would therefore be advisable to contact the operator directly to raise your concerns.
