Copy of letter attached. Please note, we as a matter of course attempt to reach out to all families by telephone in the first instance.. All parents are offered a visit during initial contact. Where families decline a visit through this conversation we currently send a 'Declined Visit' letter. This letter signposts families to Education Otherwise for advice on report writing and gives a date by which a report should be received so that the council can fulfil its 'informal enquiry'.

I understand that you have made the decision to educate your child at home in accordance with Section 7 of the Education Act 1996, where parents are responsible for ensuring their child receives an efficient and suitable education at school or otherwise.

I am writing to explain what happens next.
