

Request for:-

A breakdown of number of placements by type of provision and single age as at 31st March each year.

A breakdown of number of Children who **STARTED** to be looked-after in year by type of provision (first placement they were placed in as a looked-after child) and single age. This refers to any newly looked after child placed from 1st April to 31st March of that reporting year.

A breakdown of number of Children who **CEASED** to be looked-after in year by single age. This refers to any looked after child who ceased to be cared for by the LA from 1st April to 31st March of that reporting year.

A breakdown of **NEW** placements made by type of provision and single age. This refers to any placement made from 1st April to 31st March, therefore includes both newly looked-after CYP and those that have physically changed placements within the year. **Note:** This <u>SHOULD NOT</u> include placements that have only changed in status and not resulted in a physical placement move, therefore should exclude code: PLACE (Change in the status of placement only) or, CARPL (Change to/Implementation of Care Plan) when no physical placement move has taken place.

Number of NEW placements recorded in Tab E by type of provision and single age that were as a result of 'Placement Breakdown' in the previous placement. This refers to any placement made from 1st April to 31st March recorded as a result of the following:

ALLEG (Allegation (s47))
STAND (Standards of care concern)
APPRR (Approval removed)
CREQB (Carer(s) requests placement end due to child's behaviour)
CREQO (Carer(s) requests placement end other than due to child's behaviour)
CHILD (Child requests placement end
