This information is exempt from disclosure under Section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. The Act exempts personal data from disclosure where that disclosure breaches one of the data protection principles. Section 40(2) relies on one of three conditions being satisfied for the exemption to be engaged. The first condition - in section 40(3A)(a) - states that if disclosure would contravene the data protection principles then section 40(2) is engaged. The first data protection principle in Article 5 of the UK GDPR is that personal data processing must be lawful. Of the lawful bases for processing personal data set out in Article 6 of UK GDPR, only legitimate interests and consent would be possible. As the Council does not have the postholders' consent to share this personal data and there is no legitimate interest in putting it into the public domain, then the exemption under s40(2) is engaged and the personal data has been withheld from disclosure.
