Also a breakdown of the advertising to let the local community know. 3. Information from all three of the committees consultations. 		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The request for additional restrictions has been made by the Waste Area Manager based at the Ince-in-Makerfield Depot for Wigan Council. The request was made on the 11th April 2024 to keep the area clear on the approach to the waste recycling centre for larger vehicles which can struggle to reach the recycling centre where vehicles are parked obstructively. 2. At this time, the proposals have not been advertised and further consideration is taking place. The advertising process for proposed parking restrictions is to place a site notice on nearby lighting columns, advertise in the local paper and advertise on the local authority's website. This process allows comments or objections to the legal team. 3. We do not hold this information.
