Unable to complete this question in full due to a range of different providers. Some providers include accommodation and support as part of the total cost (so no separate cost for support) and inclusive support hours vary by provision (eg 5:1 hours, 7:1 hours, 10:1 hours, bespoke hours) whereas some providers separate costs into accommodation and support. We can only include weekly costs.

Should hourly costs be required this would take over 18+ hours as 122 files would need to be reviewed.

Current placements with On Framework Providers (Placements Northwest Framework):

- Provider 1 6 placements (17yo), 33 placements (18+yo). Average cost is £400,00 per week inclusive of support.
- Provider 2 3 placements (17yo), 1 placement (18+yo). Weekly cost is £850.00 per week (inclusive of 10 hours). Cost for additional support hours is £32.00 per hour.
- Provider 3 9 placements (17yo), 5 placements (18+yo). Average weekly cost for accommodation/utilities is £683.00 per week. Cost for additional support hours is £32.48 per hour. 5 of these placements have support hours included in the weekly cost, 9 placement have bespoke hours.
- Provider 4 2 placements (16&17yo). Cost is £1550.95 per week inclusive of support.
- Provider 5 2 placements (16yo). Average cost is £991.68 inclusive of support.
- Provider 6 1 placement (17yo). Cost is £1700.00 per week inclusive of support.
- Provider 7 1 placement (16yo). Cost is £1499.00 per week. Cost for additional support hours is £24.23 per hour
- Provider 8 14 placements (16&17yo), 4 placements (18+yo). Average cost is £1290.41 per week inclusive of support.
- Provider 9 11 placements (16&17yo), 17 placements (18+yo). Average cost is £1389.41 per week inclusive of support.
- Provider 10 –1 placement (17yo). Cost is £1460.00 per week inclusive of support.
- Provider 11 1 placement (17yo). Cost is £1625.00 per week inclusive of support.
- Provider 12 2 placements (18+yo). Cost is £899.00 per week inclusive of support.
- Provider 13 1 placement (17yo). Cost is £442.50 for accommodation/utilities. Cost of support hours is £33.93 per hours. Current hours are 10 per week.
- Provider 14 2 placements (18+). Cost is £826.80 per week inclusive of support.
