

Statement of compliance with Section 61F(5) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, as amended

As required under 8(e) of The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, the proposed Standish Neighbourhood Forum complies with Section 61F(5) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, as amended, because it meets the following requirements:

- (a) It is established for the express purpose of promoting or improving the social, economic and environmental well-being of an area that consists of or includes the neighbourhood area concerned (whether or not it is also established for the express purpose of promoting the carrying on of trades, professions or other businesses in such an area). This is set out in part 3, objective c in the Standish Voice constitution.
- (b) Its membership is open to—
 - (i) Individuals who live in the neighbourhood area concerned. This is set out in part 7.a in the Standish Voice constitution.
 - (ii) Individuals who work there (whether for businesses carried on there or otherwise). This is also set out in part 7.a in the Standish Voice constitution.
 - (iii) Individuals who are elected members of a district council any of whose area falls within the neighbourhood area concerned. This is set out in part 7.c in the Standish Voice constitution.
- (c) Its membership includes a minimum of 21 individuals each of whom—
 - (i) Lives in the neighbourhood area concerned.
 - (ii) Works there (whether for a business carried on there or otherwise).
 - (iii) Is an elected member of a district council any of whose area falls within the neighbourhood area concerned.

This is set out in part 7.e in the Standish Voice constitution directly after parts 7.a-7.d, which cover the breadth of matters set out in (c)(i)–(iii) above.
- (d) It has a written constitution. Standish Voice has a written constitution.
- (e) Such other conditions as may be prescribed. Other conditions prescribed in Regulations have been met.
