Project Overview

We are enthusiastic and motivated to transform a forgotten fenced garden into an area of beauty. Our first project is to create a HMD Green Memorial Garden, which would be Wigan's first and only. We are keen to push forward with the project to bring a space of peace and reflection to the community, linking in with local school, St Wilfrid's Primary, and helping the children there to learn new skills and gain confidence.

So far, the ground has been cleared of weeds and 15 pupils from years 4 & 5 of the school's Garden Club have worked hard to clean and weed the central 3 tier tub, ready for planting.

What support is needed:

We need support to get the space ready for planting and maintenance. This support includes: a mechanical digger to turn the currently impacted soil and rake it, metal paint to use on our fencing - ideally silver, sandblasting/cleaning of stone area.
