

Notice of Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places 2024

Wigan Council is conducting a review of polling districts and polling places as required by the Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013.

The Review will commence on 1 October 2024 and end on 31 January.

The (Acting) Returning Officer will make comments on the Boroughs current polling districts and polling places after the consultation period has ended. The (Acting) Returning Officer's representations will be made available online at www.wigan.gov.uk/elections.

Consultation

We welcome feedback on any aspect of polling districts or polling places currently used and invite comments via the consultation from interested persons or groups, particularly those with expertise in disability access issues.

Alternative proposals where the Council currently uses portable cabins would be welcomed.

Local Councillors and the Boroughs Members of Parliament will be consulted along with local community groups.
