This document explains how places were allocated at the school for admission to reception class in September 2024.

Admission number (number of places available) -30 (following a request for a variation to the Office of the Schools Adjudicator, the school's admission number was reduced from 45 to 30).

Number of preferences received on time (by the closing date) - 44

How places were allocated

Marsh Green Primary School is a community school.

All applications were processed using the 'equal preference' system as explained in the 'Admissions to Primary Schools 2024/25 booklet'.

On national offer day, 16th April 2024, 32 places were allocated to children whose applications were received before the closing date of 15 January 2024. This was based on the school's original admission number of 45.

Following national offer day, the Office of the Schools Adjudicator agreed a request from the Local Authority to reduce the school's admission number to 30. This left no places to offer to late applicants.

Applications received after the closing date of 15 January 2024 are deemed to be late and only considered after applications received on time. Changes of preference received after the closing date are also classed as late applications.
