

Directory of Homelessness and Housing-related Support Services in Wigan Borough

What are homelessness & housing-related support services?

In Wigan borough there is a wide range of services which provide advice and support to people who are having a problem related to their accommodation, homelessness or who need assistance to maintain a stable home. Housing-related support is available for practical and personal issues including things like:

- mental health problems
- · learning disabilities
- young people at risk
- · escaping domestic violence
- · leaving custody and reducing offending
- · physical or sensory disabilities
- teenage parenthood
- substance misuse problems

- setting up and maintaining a home
- developing social and domestic skills
- needing more support in later life
- budgeting and welfare benefits
- · getting involved in community activities
- personal safety and security
- finding other accommodation
- finding employment or training

Some of these services are provided directly by Wigan Council, but many are provided by 'third sector' organisations. They may be given financial support by the Council and they will be monitored to make sure the services are of good quality.

- Information, advice & guidance
- Supported housing projects
- Floating/visiting support
- Community groups
- Specialist support groups

What they do

Local or national organisations who provide impartial advice for a range of issues
Accommodation with support; including projects known as 'hostels', refuges for women and
children at risk of domestic abuse, sheltered accommodation for older people
Visits from a support worker in your own home, or wherever you are living
A range of groups including charitable organisations that provide services to the community
such as community events, furniture, practical help

Local or national organisations who provide expert specialist advice and support for specific issues.

Different services have their own referral procedures:

- Self referral services that allow you to apply directly to them.
- Referral by a professional services that require that you are referred by a professional person such as a doctor or social worker.
- Referral by a voluntary organisation services that take referrals from voluntary organisations such as community groups.

It is important to contact the service you wish to access in order to check their application and assessment procedures.
