Procedure for a Definitive Map Modification Order Application

The applicant submits an application form and plan to the Council. Notice is served on landowners. Applicant certifies to the Council that notice has been served or obtains permission to erect notices on the claimed route, if land is unregistered. The Council checks the application and supporting evidence to determine if it is valid. The application is then assessed and prioritised using a matrix and put on a list in priority order. When the application is top of the priority list, the Council considers the evidence for and against the claimed route, plus other pertinent information. A report is submitted to the Delegated Officer with a recommendation whether or not to make the Order.
