(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING) ORDER 2024

NOTICE OF PROPOSALS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of the powers under Section 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act 1984, proposes to make the Wigan Borough (Decriminalisation of Parking) (Various Roads in Wigan Borough) (Traffic Regulation Consolidation) Order 2004 (Amendment No.590) Order 2024

The effect of the Order will be to introduce no waiting at any time on:

- Alexandra Road Ashton both sides from its junction with Bryn Road South to a point 15 metres west of its junction with Bryn Road South
- Bryn Road South, Ashton west side from a point 15 metres north of its junction with Alexandra Road to a point 15 metres south of its junction with Alexandra Road

The effect of the Order will be to introduce no loading at any time on:

- Bryn Road South, Ashton west side from a point 15 metres north of its junction with Alexandra Road to a point 15 metres south of its junction with Alexandra Road
- Alexandra Road Ashton both sides from its junction with Bryn Road South to a point 15 metres west of its junction with Bryn Road South

There will be limited exceptions for the purpose of building and similar operations, removing road works and works by statutory undertakers; for local authority, Water Companies; if the vehicles are fire service or police vehicles or ambulances, (liveried vehicles) or in connection with a funeral or the avoidance of an accident.

The Order also provides that if any vehicle is left in any road or length of road affected by the Order in contravention of any provision of the Order a penalty charge (in the amount set by the Council) shall be payable and/or the vehicle may be removed.
